

AEA District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC)

- The purpose of the AEA DELAC is to provide guidance and input to the Board of Trustees, SSC, and staff on the needs of Multilingual Learners who are learning English.
- Meets 4 times per year, near AEĂ facility, dinner and childcare provided, conducted in Spanish and translated into English.

Responsibilities:

- Development of a master plan for educational programs and services for English learners.
- Conduct a schools-wide needs assessment.
- Development of a plan to ensure compliance with any applicable teacher and/or teacher aide requirements.
- Review and comment on reclassification procedures.
- Review and comment on the written notifications required to be sent to parents and guardians.
- Identify ways to make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance.
- Review site based English Learner data.
- Review site based English language programs.
- If the DELAC acts as the English Learner Parent Advisory Committee under California Education Code Sections 52063(b)(1) and 52062(a)(2), the DELAC shall also review and comment on the development or annual update of the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP).
