

Staff Grants Program





Each semester FoAEA grants up to \$12,500 for school related projects

- Grants should have a lasting impact on student development and learning and reach as many students as possible.
- A diverse team (parent/teacher reps) meet to review and approve or decline grants.

Spring semester update:

- The deadline to submit an application is this Friday, April 26.
- So far we have 4 applications for an after school cooking class, a mural camp, a recess revamp for TK and an art project at the Middle School.


